Enrollment forms must be submitted to the Columbus NAACP by February 21, 2014.

Presentations are limited to 10 minutes. Pre-judging for the presentations will take place March 3-7, 2014.

The 3 schools that score the highest during the pre-judging will perform their research at the Civil Rights Celebration on March 20, 2014 at The Jewish Community Center.
